High-altitude Syrah grown on schist. Mineral, humus, and licorice notes.

Tokyo 2024 - Domaine Monts et Merveilles 39.00 €

High-altitude Syrah grown on schist soils, from the same plot as 'Racine' but crafted differently: light, fresh, with a beautiful aromatic range of red fruits and morello cherry, featuring a subtle, pleasant spritz.

Le Revenant 2023 - Domaine de La Rouviolle 43.00 €

100% Old Vine Carignan. Round and balanced, with aromas of red and black fruits, spicy notes, and lovely freshness.

Artemisia 2018 – Domaine de l'Herbe Sainte 59.00 €

"Syrah. Aromas of red fruits, spices, and pepper, with notes of toasted vanilla.

Massamier La Mignarde

*A pioneer in **agroforestry**, the estate has integrated some fifty tree species among its vines, enriching biodiversity and soil vitality.*

The estate is also committed to a zero-input approach, without irrigation or fertilization, creating a self-sustaining and resilient ecosystem.

*This philosophy is reflected in exceptional cuvées, including the famous Domus Maximus, recognized as **one of the best French red wines** at the International Wine Challenge in 2005.*

Grenache, Syrah, Carignan. Powerful and generous, with toasted notes and very ripe red fruits, pleasantly spiced.

Domus Maximus 2020 160,00 €

Syrah, Grenache. Powerful, with aromas of very ripe red fruits, garrigue, and black olives. Exceptional length on the palate.

AOP Saint Chinian

Nestled between the Montagne Noire and the foothills of the Cévennes, the Saint-Chinian appellation stretches across a mosaic of soils: schist to the north and limestone to the south, which shape wines of character and finesse.

The diversity of its terroirs gives rise to deep, spicy reds with supple tannins and remarkable freshness.

The appellation asserts its identity through sustainable viticulture, rooted in tradition and looking toward the future.

Sentenelle 310 2022 - Domaine la Linquière 40,00 €

Syrah, Mourvèdre on schist soils.

Mineral and elegant with a lovely freshness. Aromas of jammed small black fruits, black truffle, and roasted notes. Velvety on the palate with hints of chocolate.

Rocher de Notre Dame 2019- Dom la Linquière 59.00 €

Mourvèdre on limestone and schist soils.

Aromas of licorice, cinnamon, and truffle, with notes of jammed small red fruits and chocolate. Elegant and slightly spicy tannins.

Les Pierres Chaudes 2020- Dom la Doumie 42.00 €

Mourvèdre, Carignan, Grenache.

Beautiful minerality, aromas of red fruits and very ripe morello cherries, with a fresh finish.

Clos de la Simonette 2019- Mas Champart 65.00 €

Mourvèdre, Grenache, Carignan (3,624 bottles) Notes of red fruits, a beautiful refreshing balance, and very fine tannins.

AOP Faugères

Planted on ancient schist hillsides, the Faugères appellation produces wines that are both powerful and elegant.

The reds are structured and deep, imbued with notes of garrigue and spices. Here, nature dictates the rhythm, and the winemakers elevate it with sincerity and exacting standards.

Grande Réserve 2020- Domaine Ollier Taillefer 43.00 €

Old-vine Carignan, Syrah, and Grenache on high-altitude schist soils. Elegance, garrigue, juniper, and licorice, with a beautiful freshness.

Rêve de Noé 2021 - Domaine Ollier Taillefer 68.00 €

Aged Mourvèdre and Syrah grown on schist. From exceptional vintages.

A spicy, toasty nose; rich and velvety on the palate, with lovely complexity

Les Bancèls 2021 - Domaine Cébène 46.00 €

*Syrah and Grenache on high-altitude, north-facing schist soils.
A perfect expression of the terroir, with soft, elegant tannins and a beautiful freshness.*

Belle Lurette 2023 - Domaine Cébène 60.00 €

*Old-vine Carignan and Mourvèdre on north-facing schist soils.
Complex aromas, great elegance, and a beautiful balance between ripe fruit and freshness*

Felgaria 2017 - Domaine Cébène 83.00 €

*Mourvèdre and Syrah on north-facing schist soils.
Minerality, aromatic complexity, and freshness unite in this magnificent expression of Mountain Mourvèdre. A beautiful balance between ripe fruit and freshness.*

AOP Corbières Boutenac

*An emblematic cru of the Corbières region, Boutenac sits on soils of sandstone and rounded pebbles (galets roulés). Its reds, dominated by Carignan, combine power, complexity, and a velvety texture.
A rare terroir, producing deep and breed-specific wines.*

La Serre 2020 - Château Fabre Gasparets 70.00 €

*Carignan, Mourvèdre, and Syrah.
Limited edition. Powerful nose with sweet spices; dense, fine, and silky tannins; notes of vanilla and candied fruits.*

AOP Côtes du Roussillon

Located in the highlands of Roussillon, Coume Majou was the passion project of Luc Charlier, an independent artisan-winemaker.

Driven by a free-spirited approach, uncertified yet deeply respectful of the living world, he produced sincere, powerful wines, crafted without artifice.

Now closed, the estate lives on only through its final remaining bottles.

Cuvée Majou 2009 59.00 €

Crafted from old-vine Grenache, Carignan, and Syrah, it embodies the very soul of this sun-drenched terroir: a full-bodied palate with deep aromas of black fruits, garrigue, and spices, a rare wine, brimming with emotion.

AOP Minervois

The Minervois AOP is a terroir defined by wild and sun-drenched landscapes.

Wines from this appellation, primarily crafted from Grenache, Syrah, and Carignan, are distinguished by their richness and character.

The reds are powerful, offering intense aromas of black fruits, spices, and garrigue. A warm and authentic wine, a true reflection of its terroir.

Conte des Garrigues 2020 - Dom la Prade Mari 36.00 €

Grenache, Syrah. Produced through naturo-culture. Powerful and complex, with pronounced notes of blackcurrant, spices, and garrigue.

Conte des Garrigues 2004 - Dom la Prade Mari 65.00 €

Grenache, Syrah. Produced through naturo-culture.

Extraordinary freshness for a 20-year-old wine. Complex notes of herbs and sweet garrigue spices.

Villa Lucia 2022 - Dom Cailhol Gautran 36.00 €

"Syrah, Grenache, Carignan, fruit, sweetness, and freshness.

Scents of slightly peppery garrigue, candied fruits, and notes of blackcurrant.

Cuvée Maxime 2022 - Borie de Maurel 53.00 €

100% Mourvèdre, organic wine.

Beautiful minerality, silky tannins, aromas of fig and leather, with a slightly peppery finish.

Campagne de Centeilles 2013 - Clos Centeilles 54.00 €

Cinsault and Syrah.

Mellow tannins, vibrant fruit, notes of spices, and great elegance.

Cuvée Sylla 2021 - Domaine Borie de Maurel 75,00 €

100% Syrah at an altitude of 300 meters.

A wine with complex aromas, great length on the palate, and intensely fragrant.

Cuvée Miss Terre 2019 - Le Clos du Marbrier 78,00 €

Syrah, Cinsault. Aged for 9 months in sandstone jars.

A deep wine with supple tannins; notes of leather and black fruits, slightly peppery with hints of clove.

AOP Cru la Livinière

Château de Siran is located in the heart of the AOP Cru La Livinière, a unique and prestigious terroir encompassing six villages, all bathed in a Mediterranean climate and incomparable geological richness.

Recognized as the first Cru of the Languedoc, this appellation draws its strength from varied soils, where schist and pebbles combine to offer the vines exceptional growing conditions. Varieties such as Grenache, Syrah, and Carignan find the ideal terrain here to express their full complexity and power.

The resulting wines are deep, featuring intense aromas of black fruits, spices, and garrigue, with a distinct tannic structure that grants them great aging potential.

Cuvée Féline 2023 - Domaine Borie de Maurel 38.00 €

Syrah, Grenache, Carignan - organic wine.

Red fruits, notes of thyme, garrigue, and sweet spices, with a touch of pepper.

Cuvée Mélanie 2023- 75cl - Chât Gourgazaud 44.00 €

Cuvée Mélanie 2021 - 50cl 30.00 €

Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre - organic wine.

At once fleshy, sensual, and of a rare balance.

Lune et l'autre 2022 - Domaine La Rouviole 57.00 €

Syrah, Grenache - organic wine aged in oak barrels.

Powerful, with expressions of red fruits and liquorice, and a light oaky finish.

Grand Vin 2021 - Domaine de L'Ostal 59.00 €

Syrah, Carignan, Grenache, Mourvèdre.

Full-bodied and rich on the palate, with notes of ripe black fruits and liquorice, supported by elegant tannins.

Pater Familias 2023 - Château de Gourgazaud 63,00 €

100% Grenache.

A rich and deep wine with a grand aromatic range, revealing notes of kirsch, plum, and blackcurrant.

C de Centeilles 2018 - Clos Centeilles 62.00 €

*Vin de Pays Côtes du Brian - Riveirenc Gris and Blanc, Araignan, Grenache Gris.
A complex and harmonious wine with beautiful freshness and notes of fresh almond.*

La Vigne de ma Mère 2023 - Chât Gourgazaud 65,00 €

100% Viognier - Beautiful buttercup-gold hue. A complex nose with notes of honey and almonds; dense on the palate with remarkable length and a minerality that reflects its schist terroir.



AOP Faugères

White Faugères AOP wines, crafted from varieties such as Grenache Blanc, Roussanne, and Rolle, derive their unique character from schist terroirs. These wines combine a beautiful minerality with aromas of stone fruits, citrus, and a floral touch. Fresh and balanced, they offer a pleasant roundness and great finesse on the palate.

Cuvée Allegro 2023 - Domaine Ollier Taillefer 44.00 €

Rolle and Roussanne on schist

A rich, fat, and unctuous wine with a beautiful minerality.

AOP Saint Chinian

Less renowned than their red counterparts, Saint-Chinian AOP whites deserve your full attention. They are born from contrasting terroirs of schist and limestone. These wines combine freshness, elegance, and aromatic finesse, featuring notes of white-fleshed fruits, citrus, and a subtle floral touch. Balanced and luminous, they offer a singular expression of Languedoc, striking a perfect chord between minerality and indulgence.

Cuvée Fleur de Lin 2024 - Dom la Linquière 35.00 €

Rolle, Grenache Blanc on schist.

A fine balance between minerality and fruit, with aromas of citrus and vanilla.

AOP Châteauneuf-du-Pape

"Domaine des Sénéchaux, situated at the heart of the Châteauneuf-du-Pape appellation, is one of the most prestigious estates in the Rhône Valley. Since its takeover by the Cazes family—also owners of Domaine de l'Ostal in Minervois—the estate has masterfully combined tradition and innovation to produce high-quality wines. The terroir, composed of 'galets roulés' (rounded pebbles) and clay-limestone soils, lends the wines a unique structure and expression.

Domaine des Sénéchaux 2020 80.00 €

Grenache Blanc and Roussanne, grown on stony soils.

This wine offers a beautiful balance between minerality and a richness of ripe fruit, citrus, and white flower aromas, highlighted by notes of peach and honey.

AOP Minervois

Minervois AOP white wines, crafted from varieties such as Grenache Blanc, Rolle, and Roussanne, fully express the unique character of their Mediterranean terroir.

The stony soils and intense sunshine of the region bring a beautiful minerality to these wines while preserving a pleasant freshness. They reveal a complex aromatic palette of white-fleshed fruits, citrus, and white flowers, sometimes with a subtle touch of spice.

The balance between roundness and vivacity, along with a fine length on the palate, makes white Minervois both refined and generous, perfect for pairing with a wide variety of dishes.

Les Pièces Blanches 2024 - La Rouviolle 37.00 €

Rolle, Grenache Blanc - Organic. Aromas of citrus and lemon; round and indulgent on the palate.

Villa Lucia 2023 - Domaine Cailhol Gautran 41.00 €

Grenache Blanc, Marsanne, Roussanne, and Terret.

Full-bodied with plenty of freshness; notes of stone fruits and a subtle touch of oak, leading to a lightly lemony finish.

Grand Vin blanc 2023 - Domaine de L'Ostal 56.00 €

La Livinière - Roussanne, Marsanne, Viognier.

The palate is suave and fragrant, offering a perfect balance between freshness and opulence.

Le Domaine La Prade Mari

A pioneer in the biodynamic approach and creator of the unique 'Naturo-Culture' method, this estate embodies a viticulture that respects both life and terroir. Under the direction of Éric Mari, this family domain is committed to tending the vines with a holistic approach, combining naturopathy, phytotherapy, and ancestral practices to create authentic wines that reflect an exceptional terroir. Respect for nature and the preservation of biodiversity are at the heart of this philosophy, allowing the estate to produce high-quality wines without any chemicals.

Rosé Wines

Born from red grapes vinified like whites, rosés carry on an ancient craftsmanship practiced long before today's deep reds became the norm. For centuries, wines were pale, the result of very short macerations. Modern rosé revives this tradition with newfound refinement: delicate extraction, preserved freshness, and a crystalline expression of fruit. Beyond their apparent softness, these wines demand immense precision and offer a sincere reflection of the light and subtlety of our Southern terroirs.

Le rosé Château de Gourgazaud 2024 28.00€

Syrah, Grenache. Tender hue, delicate and fruity nose. A concentrate of indulgent aromas of small red berries.

Rubis des Garrigues 2023 - La Prade Mari 32.00€

Syrah, Mourvèdre, Grenache. An original and seductive rosé born from 'Naturo-Culture'; deep pink hue with notes of strawberry and ripe red fruits

Les Amouries 2020 - Château Fabre Gasparets 45.00 €

Mourvèdre, Grenache. Considered a rosé or a light red; salmon hue with spicy and fruity notes, featuring rose petals, caramel, and red fruits.



Orange Wines

Heirs to the earliest winemaking techniques practiced since Antiquity, orange wines embody a return to the origins of white wine as it was crafted in Roman times: through the maceration of white grapes with their skins, much like a red wine. This ancient method restores body, texture, and aromatic depth to the juice, revealing notes of candied citrus, dried fruits, and spices. A vibrant, emotional wine that seamlessly blends ancestral knowledge with a contemporary spirit.

Les petits pas d'Angélique 2024 - Mas Champart 38.00€

Muscat, Grenache Gris - Limited edition (600 bottles).

A surprising wine with a very pleasant, subtle bitterness.

Le Camin 2022 - Château Fabre Gasparet 58.00 €

Viognier - Vin de France.

Aged in jars and barrels; intense, rich, and mineral on the palate.

Notes of gentian with a pleasant, subtle bitterness on the finish.

Les Bigradiers 2021 - Massamier la Mignarde 62.00€

Sauvignon Blanc – Vin de France.

A deep orange hue reminiscent of certain brandies. Delicate nose with botanical notes of lemon balm, liquorice, verbena, and apple.

Sweet White & Red Wines

The fruit of extreme patience and meticulous attention, sweet wines are born from a mastered imbalance. Through passerillage (drying on the vine) or noble rot, the grapes concentrate their sugar, aromas, and light. It is a rare alchemy, long celebrated at the finest tables, where the wine turns to velvet, evoking honey, candied apricot, quince, and sometimes orange peel. Behind every sip lies a climate, a hand, and a wager against time. A wine of slowness, depth, and intensity.

Noble Gold - Domaine de l'Herbe Sainte - 50 cl 34.00€

Overripe Chardonnay. Golden yellow. Fine and complex aromas of dried figs, dried apricots, and exotic fruits.

Cuvée Mosaïque - Domaine la Linquière - 50 cl 36.00€

A blend of 9 overripe grape varieties (predominantly Muscat), aged for 6 months in oak barrels. Aromas of dried fruits, honey, apricot, and white flowers.

L'Erme 2008 - Clos Centeilles - 50cl 80.00€

Passerillé Grenache Gris

Born from an ancient plot of Grenache Gris and hand-harvested between November and December, this rare wine is the result of natural passerillage on the vine, a demanding method guided only by the breath of the wind and the passage of time. Concentration occurs slowly, berry by berry, under the Minervois sky. The result is an ethereal sweetness, marked by aromas of candied fruits, citrus, and dried fruits, supported by a saline backbone and an unexpected freshness. L'Erme tells the story of both a forgotten vineyard and a viticultural gesture of infinite precision.

Vin Doux Naturel, 100% Black Grenache, crafted in the style of a Maury.

Les 3 André - château Fabre Gasparets - 50 cl 80.00 €

Vin de Liqueur, 100% Black Grenache (70-year-old vines). A unique blend of 45 different vintages.

Limited production of 1,000 bottles per year. Oxidative aging. Amber hue; rich and complex on the palate with aromas of walnut, mocha, orange, and candied fruits.

AOP Muscat de Saint-Jean-de-Minervois

Domaine de Barroubio

Perched on the limestone plateaus of Saint-Jean-de-Minervois, Domaine de Barroubio embodies the elegance of this boutique AOP, dedicated to Muscat Blanc à Petits Grains. The altitude, luminous soils, and dry climate give birth to Vins Doux Naturels of rare finesse, blending aromatic purity with mineral freshness.

Etiquette Noire - 75 cl 30.00 €

Muscat à Petits Grains.

Aromas of dried pear-scented flowers and candied citrus.

Cuvée Bleue 2018 - 50 cl 30.00 €

Muscat à Petits Grains.

A blend of sweetness and finesse, combining the classic Muscat flavor with candied citrus; full-bodied and rich on the palate.

AOP Champagnes

De Sousa - blanc de blancs 75cl 100.00 €

100% Chardonnay, currently in conversion to biodynamic farming.

Golden hue with fine bubbles; a powerful nose featuring highly expressive floral notes, with hints of eucalyptus and roasted coffee. Round on the palate with beautiful length and a pleasant, fresh finish.

De Sousa - blanc de noirs 75cl 130,00 €

AOP Crémant de Limoux

Les Graiménous - Domaine J. Laurens - 75 cl 42.00 €

Brut Crémant, crafted using the traditional method. A blend of

Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc, Pinot Noir, and a touch of Mauzac. This
