Our Garden, a Sanctuary for Life

At Château de Siran, we move forward with a simple conviction: preserving our surroundings gives meaning to everything we offer.

The house lives in harmony with nature.

We envisioned a living garden where nature reclaims its place. When we first arrived, it was a mineral landscape. For nearly 16 years, we have allowed it to rediscover its vitality. No chemical treatments are used, with the sole exception of our ancient boxwood trees (over 400 years old), which are protected from the box tree moth. Each year, we plant more to encourage greater diversity, beauty, and life.

Today, biodiversity has returned. Nesting boxes, insect hotels, seeds in winter, and a pond to quench thirst... everything is designed to welcome the living world.

Hoopoes, European goldfinches, tits, blackbirds, robins, redstarts, and doves inhabit the garden, its untrimmed hedges, and shaded corners. Butterflies dance among the buddleia and nectar-rich plants.

You may be lucky enough to spot the pair of kestrels that nest nearby; every year, they bring their young to soar above the jasmine in the courtyard. Looking up, you might see Short-toed Snake Eagles, buzzards, kites, and occasionally a Bonelli's eagle or a Golden eagle.

Swallows define the summer sky, while pipistrelle bats live discreetly behind the shutters. Even the gravel is evolving: in the restaurant area, the grass is slowly reclaiming its place. This brings us profound joy. The earth is working for tomorrow, and we are its companions.

In the South, it is a given: water must be respected. We have two wells that allow for mindful drip irrigation, preserving this precious resource.

Rooted Cuisine

Our cuisine follows the rhythm of the seasons. Thomas prioritizes local producers, whom we would be delighted to introduce to you: La Pode, Moulin de la Restanque, Granhota, honey from Tourouzelle, cheeses from Combebelles, jams from Azille, soaps from Bise Minervois...

And of course, our winemaker friends, who bring our wine list to life.

In partnership with Domaine de Massamier, we offer a stroll through vineyards and nature to their estate, which is committed to agroforestry, where trees and vines flourish side by side.

Temperature Management

Here, the thick stone walls naturally hold the cool air, while the shutters regulate both light and temperature. In summer, we open the windows at night and close them during the day to keep the interior fresh; in winter, we act to preserve the warmth.

Reduce and Recycle

Waste sorting is organized throughout the establishment and is easily accessible on every floor.

In the kitchen, nothing is wasted: peelings are transformed into stocks, and organic matter nourishes the compost, which eventually returns to the earth.

Linens are changed at your own pace; simply place your towels in the shower or bathtub when you wish for them to be laundered.

Discover Differently

We invite you to explore the region on foot or by bicycle. A local partner can deliver bicycles and electric scooters directly to the Château.

The trails, maintained in part by the Ensirandan association, lead to the local capitelles (dry-stone huts) and the surrounding landscapes. We would be delighted to guide you and share the stories of this land, its history, and that of Château de Siran.
